Paramount

Meaning: More important than anything else.

Synonyms: Supreme, principal, dominant.

Antonyms: Minor, insignificant.

Example:

Protecting the environment is paramount to ensuring a sustainable future.

Reinforce

Meaning: To strengthen or support an idea or feeling.

Synonyms : Fortify, bolster, support.

Antonyms : Undermine, weaken.

Example :

The evidence presented in the court reinforced the lawyer's argument.

Trajectory

Meaning : A path, progression, or line of development.

Synonyms : Course, route, track.

Antonyms : Deviation, detour.

Example :

The company's financial trajectory has been positive over the past year.

Hypernationalistic

Meaning: Excessively proud of one's country, often at the expense of others.

Synonyms: Jingoistic, chauvinistic.

Antonyms: Cosmopolitan, internationalist.

Example:

Hypernationalistic sentiments can sometimes lead to international conflicts.

Clarify

Meaning : To make something clearer or easier to understand.

Synonyms : *Explain, elucidate, simplify.*

Antonyms : *Obscure, confuse.*

Example :

The professor clarified the complex theory for the students.

Antagonize

Meaning : To cause someone to become hostile.

Synonyms : **Provoke, alienate, irritate.**

Antonyms : **Pacify, soothe, reconcile.**

Example:

His remarks antagonized many of his colleagues.

Rhetoric

Meaning : *Effective or persuasive speaking or writing, often regarded as insincere.*

Synonyms : **Oratory, bombast, discourse.**

Antonyms : **Silence, simplicity.**

Example :

The politician's rhetoric failed to address the real issues.

Provocation

Meaning : An action or speech that incites someone to act, often in anger.

Synonyms : Instigation, incitement, provocation.

Antonyms : Pacification, appeasement.

Example :

The protestors reacted strongly to the police's provocation.

Stability

Meaning: A state where something is not likely to change or fail.

Synonyms : Balance, steadiness, firmness.

Antonyms : Instability, volatility.

Example:

Political stability is essential for economic growth.

Bilateral

Meaning : Involving or relating to two sides, parties, or countries.

Synonyms : Mutual, reciprocal, two-sided.

Antonyms : Unilateral, one-sided.

Example :

The two nations signed a bilateral trade agreement.
