Resilience



Meaning : The ability to recover quickly from difficulties.

Synonyms : Toughness, durability, elasticity. Antonyms : Fragility, vulnerability.

Example : The community showed resilience in rebuilding after the flood.

Unequal

Meaning: Not equal in status, rights, or opportunities.

Synonyms : Disproportionate, inequitable. Antonyms : Equal, balanced, fair.

Example : The policy was criticized for fostering unequal treatment.





Corneal

Meaning : Relating to the cornea of the eye.

Synonyms : Ocular, visual (contextual). Antonyms : N/A (specific term).

Example : Efforts to address corneal blindness have been intensified.





Mandate

Meaning : An official order or commission to do something.

Synonyms : *Command, directive, authorization.* Antonyms : *Refusal, ban.*

Example :

The government was given a clear mandate to implement reforms.





Epidemic

Meaning : A widespread occurrence of an infectious disease in a community at a particular time.

Synonyms : Outbreak, plague, contagion. Antonyms : Containment, isolation.

Example : The region faced an epidemic of viral infections.





Accessibility

Meaning : The quality of being easy to reach, enter, or use.

Synonyms : Availability, approachability. Antonyms : Inaccessibility, exclusivity.

Example : Accessibility to education remains a challenge in remote areas.





Dignity

Meaning : The state or quality of being worthy of respect.

Synonyms : Nobility, decorum, grace. Antonyms : Dishonor, indignity.

Example : He maintained his dignity even during tough times.





Democratizing

Meaning : Making something accessible to everyone.

Synonyms : Equalizing, popularizing. Antonyms : Centralizing, monopolizing.

Example : Technology is democratizing access to education worldwide.



Scars



Meaning : Marks left by a wound, either physically or emotionally.

Synonyms : Marks, blemishes, trauma. Antonyms : Healing, renewal.

Example : The war left deep scars on the nation's psyche.





Policy Paralysis

Meaning : Inaction or indecision by policymakers, often due to political constraints.

Synonyms : Stalemate, deadlock. Antonyms : Action, resolution.

Example : Policy paralysis hindered the implementation of crucial reforms
