#### Repercussions

*Meaning* : Unintended and usually adverse outcomes of an action or decision.

Synonyms : Consequences, effects, aftermath. Antonyms : Causes, origins.

Example :

The economic repercussions of the pandemic were felt across the globe.





#### Exacerbate

*Meaning* : To make a problem or situation worse.

Synonyms : Aggravate, worsen, amplify. Antonyms : Alleviate, improve, mitigate.

*Example* : Delayed interventions can exacerbate climate change effects.





#### Resilient

*Meaning* : Able to recover quickly from setbacks or difficulties.

Synonyms : Robust, adaptable, strong. Antonyms : Vulnerable, fragile, weak.

*Example* : Communities must be resilient to withstand natural disasters.





## Ubiquitous

*Meaning* : Present or found everywhere.

Synonyms : Omnipresent, pervasive, universal. Antonyms : Rare, uncommon.

*Example* : Smartphones have become ubiquitous in modern society.





## Inevitable

*Meaning* : Certain to happen; unavoidable.

Synonyms : Unavoidable, certain, destined. Antonyms : Avoidable, uncertain, preventable.

**Example** : With rapid urbanization, traffic congestion seems inevitable.





# Ambiguity

*Meaning* : The quality of being open to more than one interpretation.

Synonyms : Uncertainty, vagueness, obscurity. Antonyms : Clarity, certainty, explicitness.

**Example** : The ambiguity in the policy led to confusion among stakeholders.





## Mitigation

*Meaning* : The action of reducing the severity of something.

Synonyms : Alleviation, reduction, relief. Antonyms : Intensification, aggravation.

#### **Example**:

Governments must focus on mitigation strategies to combat air pollution.





## Apathetic

*Meaning* : Showing or feeling no interest or concern.

Synonyms : Indifferent, dispassionate, unresponsive. Antonyms : Enthusiastic, passionate, concerned.

*Example* : Voter apathy can undermine democratic processes.





## Proliferation

*Meaning* : A rapid increase in numbers.

Synonyms : Growth, multiplication, spread. Antonyms : Decline, reduction, contraction.

Example :

The proliferation of online platforms has transformed communication.





## **Obsolete**

*Meaning* : No longer in use; outdated.

Synonyms : Outmoded, archaic, antiquated. Antonyms : Modern, contemporary, up-to-date.

*Example* : Typewriters have become obsolete in the digital era.
