### **Panacea**

Meaning: A solution for all problems or difficulties.

# Disproportionate

Meaning: Out of proportion in size, number, or importance.

Synonyms: Excessive, unequal, unbalanced.

Antonyms: Proportionate, balanced, equivalent.

#### Example:

"The punishment was disproportionate to the crime committed."



# Sustainability

Meaning: The ability to maintain or continue something over time.

Synonyms: Durability, endurance, viability.

Antonyms: Unsustainability, short-lived, instability.

#### Example:

"Renewable energy is key to achieving sustainability."



### Coordination

Meaning: The process of organizing people or groups to work together efficiently.

Synonyms: Collaboration, synchronization, alignment.

Antonyms: Disorganization, discord, disharmony.

### Example:

"Better coordination among agencies is necessary for disaster response."



### Governance

Meaning: The action or manner of governing a state or organization.

Synonyms: Administration, management, regulation.

Antonyms: Mismanagement, anarchy, neglect.

### Example:

"Transparency is a crucial aspect of good governance."
