Militia

Meaning: A military force raised from the civilian population to supplement a regular army in emergencies.

Crackdown

Meaning: Severe or harsh enforcement of rules and regulations.

Detain

Rebel

Federal

Meaning: Relating to a system of government where several states form a unity but remain independent in internal affairs.

Synonyms: Centralized, Unified, National.

Antonyms: Unitary, Decentralized.

Example:

The country adopted a federal structure to balance power between the central and state governments.



Precarious

Meaning: Not securely held or in position; dangerously likely to fall or collapse.

Synonyms: Unstable, Insecure, Risky.

Antonyms: Stable, Secure, Firm.

Example:

The precarious ladder swayed under the worker's weight.



Impunity

Meaning: Exemption from punishment or consequences of an action.

Synonyms: Immunity, Exemption, Privilege.

Antonyms: Accountability, Liability.

Example:

The corruption scandal revealed how officials acted with impunity.



Resilience

Meaning: The capacity to recover quickly from difficulties.

Synonyms: Fortitude, Toughness, Adaptability.

Antonyms: Fragility, Weakness.

Example:

Her resilience in the face of adversity inspired everyone.



Ubiquitous

Meaning: Present, appearing, or found everywhere.

Synonyms: Omnipresent, Pervasive, Universal.

Antonyms: Rare, Absent.

Example:

Smartphones have become ubiquitous in modern society.



Austerity

Meaning: Sternness or severity of manner or attitude; also, strictness in spending.

Synonyms: Frugality, Rigidity, Asceticism.

Antonyms: Extravagance, Opulence.

Example:

The government imposed austerity measures to reduce the budget deficit.
