Precarious



Meaning: Not securely held; uncertain or risky.

Synonyms: Insecure, unstable, perilous. Antonyms: Secure, stable, safe.

Example: The precarious economic situation demands immediate attention.





Convergence

Meaning: The process of coming together or becoming similar.

Synonyms: Union, merging, alignment. Antonyms: Divergence, separation, disconnection.

Example:

The convergence of technology and healthcare is revolutionizing patient care.





Resilience

Meaning: The capacity to recover quickly from difficulties.

Synonyms: Fortitude, toughness, adaptability. Antonyms: Fragility, vulnerability, weakness.

Example: Communities affected by natural disasters showed remarkable resilience.





Ambiguity

Meaning: The quality of being open to more than one interpretation.

Synonyms: Vagueness, uncertainty, obscurity. Antonyms: Clarity, definiteness, precision.

Example: The ambiguity in the statement caused widespread confusion.





Sovereignty

Meaning: Supreme power or authority.

Synonyms: Autonomy, independence, self-governance. Antonyms: Subjugation, dependence, colonization.

Example: Sovereignty must be respected in international relations.





Mitigation

Meaning: The action of reducing severity or seriousness.

Synonyms: Alleviation, reduction, lessening. Antonyms: Aggravation, intensification, escalation.

Example: Effective climate policies focus on mitigation of greenhouse gases.





Exacerbate

Meaning: To make a problem, bad situation, or negative feeling worse.

Synonyms: Aggravate, worsen, intensify. Antonyms: Alleviate, improve, soothe.

Example: Economic inequality exacerbates social tensions.





Reconciliation

Meaning: The restoration of friendly relations.

Synonyms: Resolution, settlement, rapprochement. Antonyms: Conflict, discord, estrangement.

Example: The treaty led to a historic reconciliation between the two nations.





Perception

Meaning: The way in which something is understood or interpreted.

Synonyms: Viewpoint, understanding, insight. Antonyms: Misinterpretation, ignorance, blindness.

Example:

Public perception of the policy is largely positive.

Innovation



Meaning: The introduction of new ideas or methods.

Synonyms: Creativity, invention, originality. Antonyms: Imitation, stagnation, replication.

Example: Innovation drives the success of the technology sector.
