# Conflagration

*Meaning*: A large, destructive fire or a conflict of great intensity.

Synonyms: Blaze, inferno, turmoil Antonyms: Calm, peace, tranquility

#### **Example:**

The recent political conflagration has highlighted the need for electoral reforms.





#### Espouse

*Meaning*: To support, adopt, or advocate for a cause or belief.

*Synonyms*: Embrace, uphold, advocate *Antonyms*: Oppose, renounce, reject

Example:

The government espouses sustainable development to counter climate change.





#### Insouciance

*Meaning*: Casual lack of concern; indifference.

Synonyms: Nonchalance, carelessness, apathy Antonyms: Concern, anxiety, attentiveness

**Example:** 

Her insouciance about deadlines created friction in the team.





#### Inexorable

*Meaning*: Impossible to stop, prevent, or persuade.

Synonyms: Relentless, unyielding, unstoppable Antonyms: Flexible, lenient, merciful

#### **Example:**

The inexorable rise in global temperatures demands immediate action.





#### Pernicious

*Meaning*: Having a harmful effect, especially in a subtle way.

Synonyms: Detrimental, malicious, insidious Antonyms: Beneficial, benign, harmless

**Example**: The pernicious influence of misinformation is undermining democracy.





## Redoubtable

*Meaning*: Formidable, especially as an opponent; commanding respect.

*Synonyms*: Fearsome, formidable, awe-inspiring *Antonyms*: Unimpressive, weak, unimposing

**Example**: She emerged as a redoubtable advocate for gender equality.





# **Ephemeral**

*Meaning*: Lasting for a very short time.

Synonyms: Transient, fleeting, momentary Antonyms: Permanent, enduring, lasting

*Example*: The ephemeral beauty of the sunset left everyone in awe.





# Obfuscate

*Meaning*: To render obscure, unclear, or unintelligible.

Synonyms: Confuse, obscure, cloud Antonyms: Clarify, illuminate, explain

Example:

The politician's vague statements were designed to obfuscate the issue.





## Desuetude

*Meaning*: A state of disuse or inactivity.

Synonyms: Obsolescence, neglect, abandonment Antonyms: Use, activity, revival

*Example*: The desuetude of traditional crafts is a concern for cultural historians.





## Equanimity

*Meaning*: Mental calmness and composure, especially in difficult situations.

Synonyms: Composure, serenity, tranquility Antonyms: Agitation, anxiety, hysteria

#### Example:

The leader's equanimity during the crisis reassured the citizens.
