



Constrained

Meaning: Forced or compelled to act in a particular way.

Synonyms: Restricted, compelled, confined.

Antonyms: Unrestrained, free, liberated.

Example:

The government's constrained measures failed to address public concerns effectively.

Contention

Meaning: Disagreement or an argument.

Synonyms: Dispute, conflict, debate.

Antonyms: Agreement, harmony, accord.

Example:

There was significant contention over the allocation of funds.



Salience

Meaning: The quality of being particularly noticeable or important.

Synonyms: Prominence, significance, relevance.

Antonyms: Insignificance, triviality, obscurity.

Example:

The salience of environmental policies has increased in recent years.

Diminishing

Meaning: Becoming less or reduced.

Synonyms: Reducing, decreasing, declining.

Antonyms: Increasing, growing, augmenting.

Example:

The effectiveness of the medicine is diminishing over time.

Latent

Meaning: Existing but not yet active or developed.

Synonyms: Dormant, hidden, concealed.

Antonyms: Active, visible, manifest.

Example:

The new policies aim to unlock the latent potential of the rural economy.



Irreversible

Meaning: Not able to be undone or changed.

Synonyms: Permanent, unalterable, immutable.

Antonyms: Reversible, temporary, flexible.

Example:

Climate change poses irreversible consequences to the ecosystem.



Metamorphosed

Meaning: Changed completely in form or nature.

Synonyms: Transformed, altered, evolved.

Antonyms: Stagnated, maintained, preserved.

Example:

Over the years, the city has metamorphosed into a bustling metropolis.



Resurgence

Meaning: A revival or renewed interest in something.

Synonyms: Revival, comeback, rebirth.

Antonyms: Decline, cessation, regression.

Example:

The resurgence of traditional crafts has bolstered local economies.



Heinous

Meaning: Very wicked or shockingly evil.

Synonyms: Atrocious, horrific, monstrous.

Antonyms: Admirable, commendable, virtuous.

Example:

The heinous crimes were met with widespread condemnation.



Vengeance

Meaning: Punishment inflicted as a retaliation for an injury or wrong.

Synonyms: Retribution, reprisal, revenge.

Antonyms: Forgiveness, mercy, pardon.

Example:

The protagonist sought vengeance for the injustices faced by his family.
