ANSWER WITH EXPLANATION



1. **Answer**: (b)

Explanation: The subject "amendments" is plural, so the correct verb is "aim," not "aims."

2. **Answer**: (b)

Explanation: The subject "Supreme Court" is singular, so the correct verb is "has clarified," not "have clarified."

3. **Answer**: (c)

Explanation: The subject "efforts" is plural, so the correct verb is "have been initiated," not "has been initiated."



4. **Answer**: (c)

Explanation: The subject "report" is singular, so the correct verb is "is being reviewed," not "are being reviewed."

5. **Answer**: (b)

Explanation: The subject "impact" is singular, so the correct verb is "has been devastating," not "have been devastating."

6. **Answer**: (b)

Explanation: The verb should agree with the closest subject, "documents," which is plural. The correct verb is "provide."



7. **Answer**: (d)

Explanation: The sentence is grammatically correct.

8. **Answer**: (c)

Explanation: The correct phrase is "compliance with," not "compliance to."

9. **Answer**: (b)

Explanation: The subject "measures" is plural, so the correct verb is "are commendable," not "is commendable."



10. **Answer**: (b)

Explanation: The subject "number" is singular, so the correct verb is "has raised," not "have raised."

11. **Answer**: (c)

Explanation: The subject "majority of women" is plural, so the correct verb is "continue," not "continues."

12. **Answer**: (d)

Explanation: The sentence is grammatically correct.



13. **Answer**: (c)

Explanation: The article "a" should be removed, as "pillars" is plural. The correct phrase is "key pillars of democracy."

14. **Answer**: (b)

Explanation: The subject "percentage" is singular, so the correct verb is "has declined," not "have declined."

15. **Answer**: (d)

Explanation: The sentence is grammatically correct.
