Unconscionable

Meaning: Not right or reasonable; unacceptably excessive.

Synonyms: Unreasonable, excessive, outrageous.

Antonyms: Fair, just, reasonable.

Example:

The company's unconscionable delay in responding to customer complaints tarnished its reputation.

Pejorative

Meaning: Expressing contempt or disapproval.

Synonyms: Disparaging, derogatory, demeaning.

Antonyms: Complimentary, laudatory, approving.

Example:

Using pejorative language to describe others can lead to misunderstandings and conflicts.

Objectionable

Meaning: Arousing distaste or opposition; unpleasant or offensive.

Synonyms: Offensive, unacceptable, inappropriate.

Antonyms: Acceptable, agreeable, pleasant.

Example:

The committee found the proposed policy changes objectionable and voted against them.

Refrain

Meaning: To stop oneself from doing something.

Synonyms: Abstain, desist, withhold.

Antonyms: Indulge, partake, engage.

Example:

Despite the provocation, she refrained from making any harsh comments.

Persist

Meaning: To continue firmly in an opinion or course of action despite difficulty or opposition.

Synonyms: Persevere, continue, endure.

Antonyms: Quit, surrender, cease.

Example:

He persisted in his studies despite facing numerous challenges.

Frustratingly

Meaning: In a way that causes frustration; annoyingly.

Synonyms: Annoyingly, vexingly, irritatingly.

Antonyms: Pleasantly, agreeably, satisfyingly.

Example:

The project was frustratingly delayed due to unforeseen technical issues.

Implementation

Meaning: The process of putting a decision or plan into effect.

Synonyms: Execution, enactment, application.

Antonyms: Neglect, disregard, abandonment.

Example:

The successful implementation of the new policy improved workplace efficiency.

Shrinking

Meaning: Becoming smaller in size or amount.

Synonyms: Diminishing, decreasing, contracting.

Antonyms: Expanding, increasing, growing.

Example:

The shrinking budget forced the team to cut down on expenses.

Inappropriate

Meaning: Not suitable or proper in the circumstances.

Synonyms: Unsuitable, improper, unseemly.

Antonyms: Appropriate, suitable, proper.

Example:

Wearing casual attire to the formal event was deemed inappropriate.

Prejudices

Meaning: Preconceived opinions not based on reason or actual experience.

Synonyms: Biases, preconceptions, partialities.

Antonyms: Impartiality, fairness, objectivity.

Example:

Overcoming deep-seated prejudices is essential for building an inclusive society.
