Mission Milestone	The 18th joint hydrographic mission between the two nations.
Area Covered	Extensive area of approximately 35,000 square nautical miles .
Date of Completion	October 26, 2025 (Conducted under an existing MoU).

Strategic Importance and Outcomes

- **Blue Economy Support:** The survey data (fairsheet formally handed over) will significantly contribute to Mauritius's **Blue Economy** goals, aiding in:
 - **Marine Charting** (for safer navigation).
 - **Coastal Regulation.**
 - **Resource Management** (e.g., seabed minerals, fishing zones).
 - **Long-term Environmental Planning.**

Strategic Importance and Outcomes

- **Capacity Building:** Six personnel from various Mauritian ministries embarked onboard INS Sutlej for **hands-on training** in modern hydrographic techniques.
- **Maritime Security:** The mission included joint **EEZ surveillance** and **anti-piracy patrols** with the Mauritius National Coast Guard.
- **Alignment with Vision:** The mission aligns with India's overarching maritime vision of **MAHASAGAR—Mutual and Holistic Advancement for Security and Growth Across the Regions** (an expansion of the earlier SAGAR vision).
